



Need help with your immigration forms? If you are not sure what immigration benefit to apply for, or which forms to submit, then you may need immigration legal advice from an authorized service provider. Authorized service providers are attorneys in good standing and representatives accredited by the Department of Justice (DOJ). They are allowed to give you advice about which documents to submit, explain immigration options that you may have, and communicate with USCIS about your case.

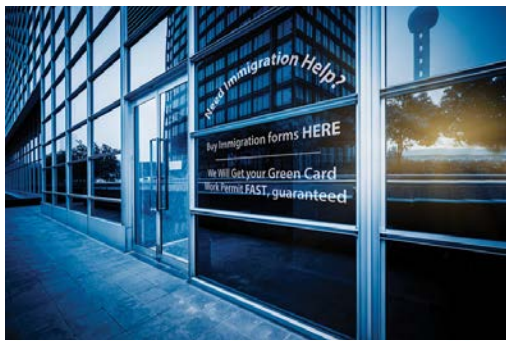

Have you been the victim of an immigration scam? Did you know the Federal Trade Commission can help? Call 1-877-382-4357 or go to www.ftc.gov/complaint.

The FTC does not resolve individual complaints. Instead, the FTC enters complaints in a secure online database used by law enforcement worldwide, including many federal, state and local officials, who spot trends and build cases. The more information you can give, the more helpful your report is to the person who will investigate. Investigators are grateful for as much information as you feel comfortable giving.

State of California Residents: Did you know that an immigration consultant in the state of California:

- Must provide a contract for immigration consultant services in English and the client's language;
- Must provide a signed receipt on his/her letterhead to you, the client, for each payment made;
- Be bonded with the State of California; and
- Cannot charge fees for USCIS Legal Forms.
