#### **MULTI-PARTY LITIGATION**

Class Action: Named representatives will be permitted to sue on behalf of a class if:

Requirements: Plaintiff, in the complaint, must propose class-action treatment.

Αll

- (1) <u>Commonality:</u> there must be questions of law or fact common to the class
- A (2) Adequacy: representative parties will fairly and adequately protect the interests of the class
  - N | (3) Numerosity: class must be "so numerous that joinder of all members is impracticable
  - T (4) Typicality: the claims or defenses of the representatives must be "typical" of the class

## <u>Types</u> → linkage between class members

1 Y P E

- (1) Separate actions create risk of <u>inconsistent results</u> or substantially <u>impair interests of absent members</u> of the class
- (2) D's conduct was based on the characteristics of the P class <u>making injunctive or</u> <u>declaratory relief appropriate</u> (vs \$ damages)
- (3) <u>Questions of law or fact common to class members predominate</u> over questions affecting individual members <u>& class action is superior</u> to other methods of adjudication.

## **Procedures** (management problems for the courts)

- 1) Certify: at an early, practicable time court must:
  - determine whether the above requirements are met and then
  - enter an order either granting or denying certification as a class action, considering:
    - interest of individual control
    - o extent of litigation elsewhere on same subject
    - o desirability of having whole package in court
    - o difficulties in managing the class
- 2) <u>Define</u> the <u>class</u> as well as <u>claims</u>, issues, or <u>defenses</u> and may:
  - <u>Limited Class Treatment</u> to certain issues or divide the proposed class into independently treated subclasses.
- 3) Appoint Class Counsel: must fairly and adequately represent the interests of the class.

### **Jurisdiction and Venue limitations**

Only names parties are considered regarding (not all class members) Diversity of citizenship (CAFA=Aggregate >\$5M)
Service of process (but all π must have notice&
Venue opt in/out rights if \$ damages)

# CAFA re: interstate class actions

Addressed  $\pi$  lawyers' manipulation of state courts. Federal Crts now have original jdx when:

- minimal diversity between any  $\pi$  member of the class and any  $\Delta$  and
- $\pi$  class contains at least <u>100 members</u> and their claims aggregated together <u>exceed \$5M</u>. <u>Removal:</u> Any  $\Delta$  can <u>remove</u> such a class action to the local federal district court.
